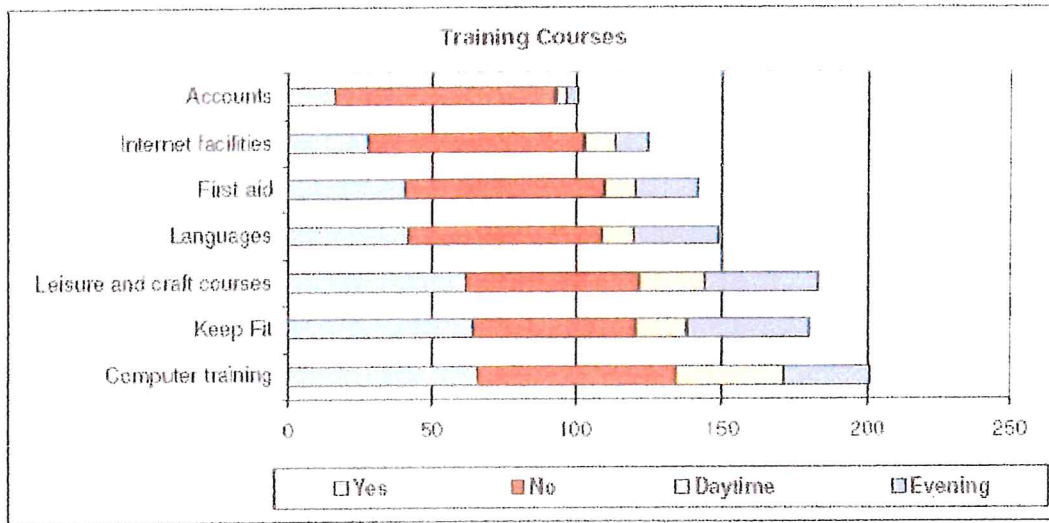

Would you or any member of your household use any of the following training courses, if offered in Brinklow? If so, do you have a preferred time?



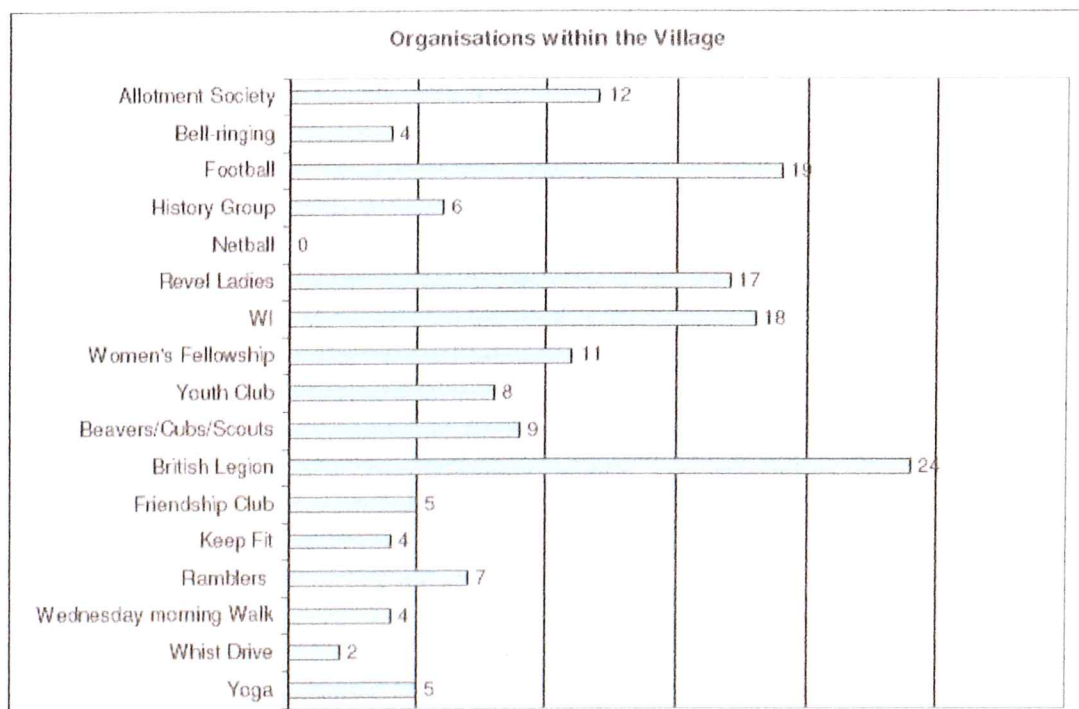
